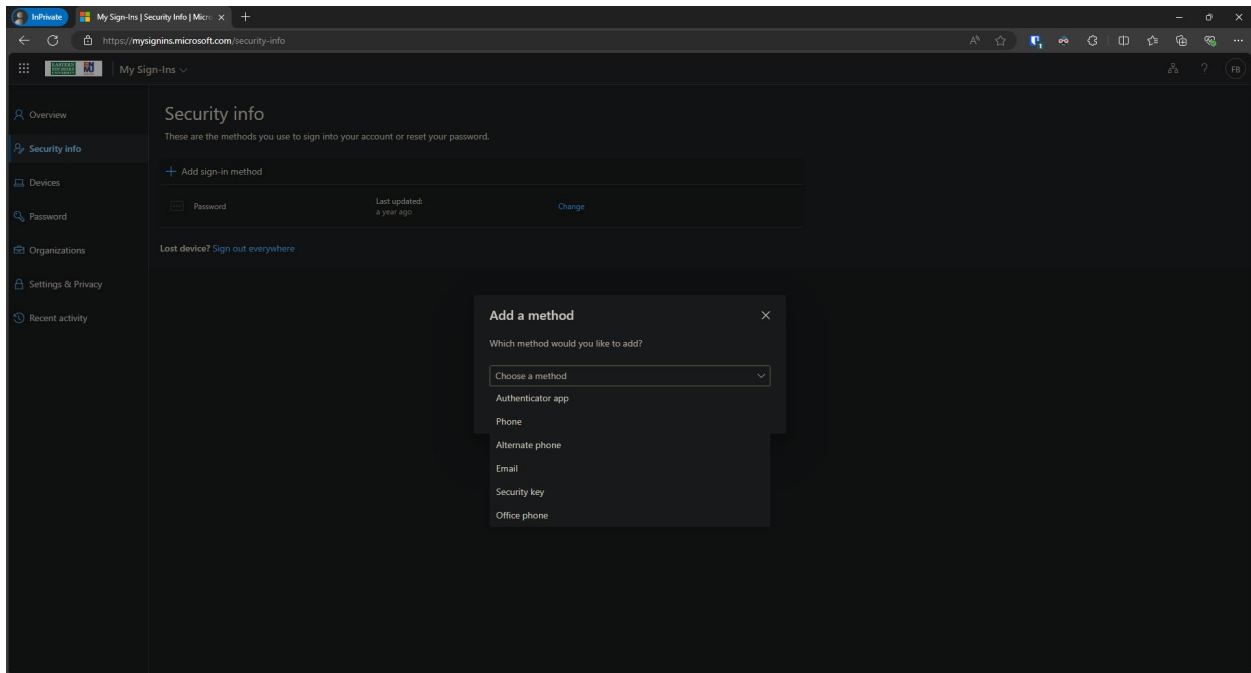


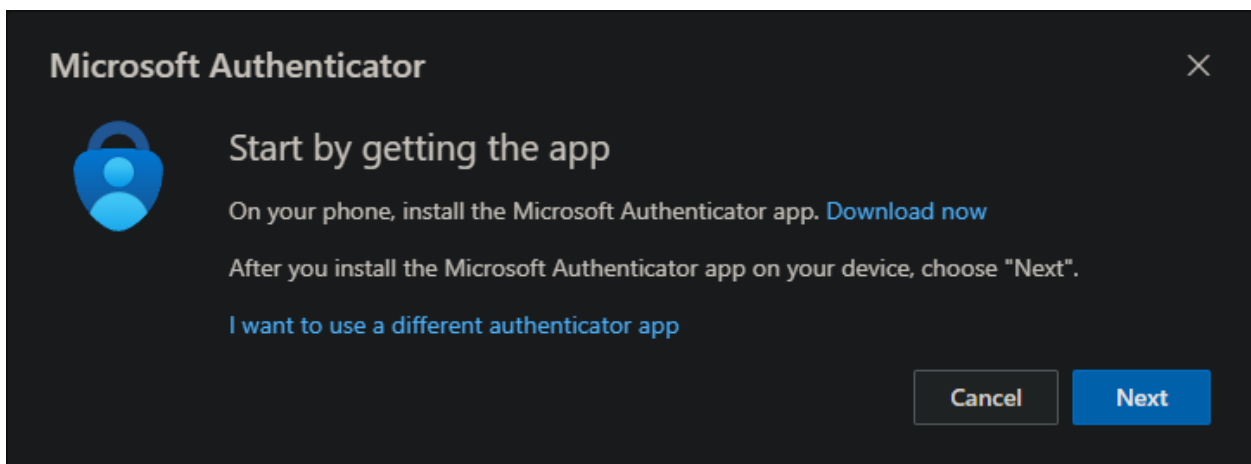
# Add the Microsoft Authenticator App to your ENMU Account

ITS recommends using the Microsoft Authenticator app as one of your authentication methods for Self-Service Password Reset (SSPR) and Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA).

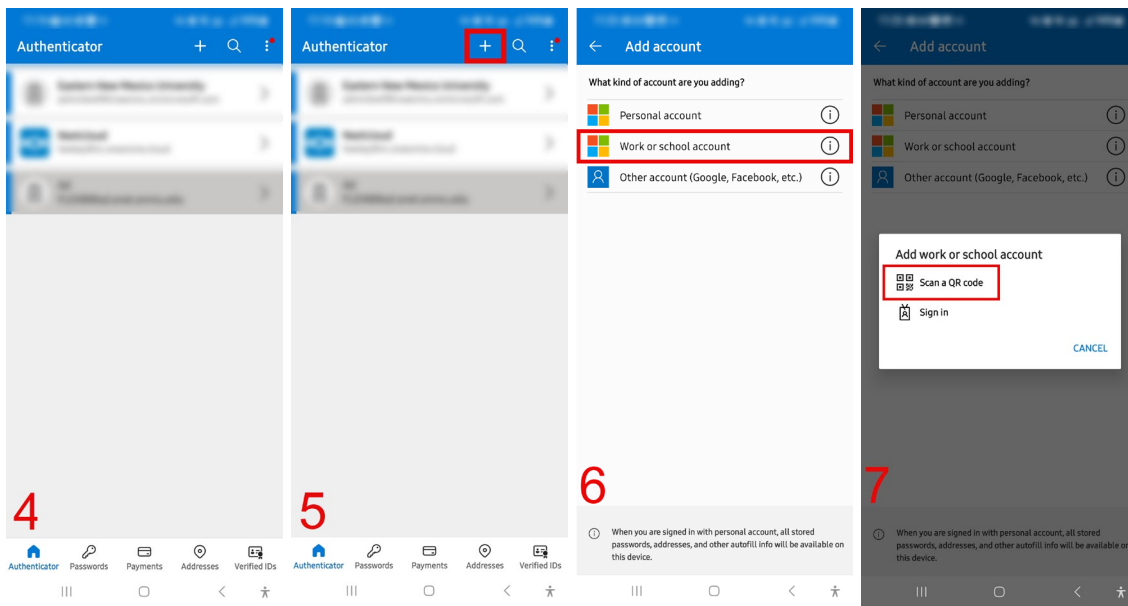
1. Follow the steps from the **Register for Self-Service Password Reset** guide to be presented with a list of available authentication methods.



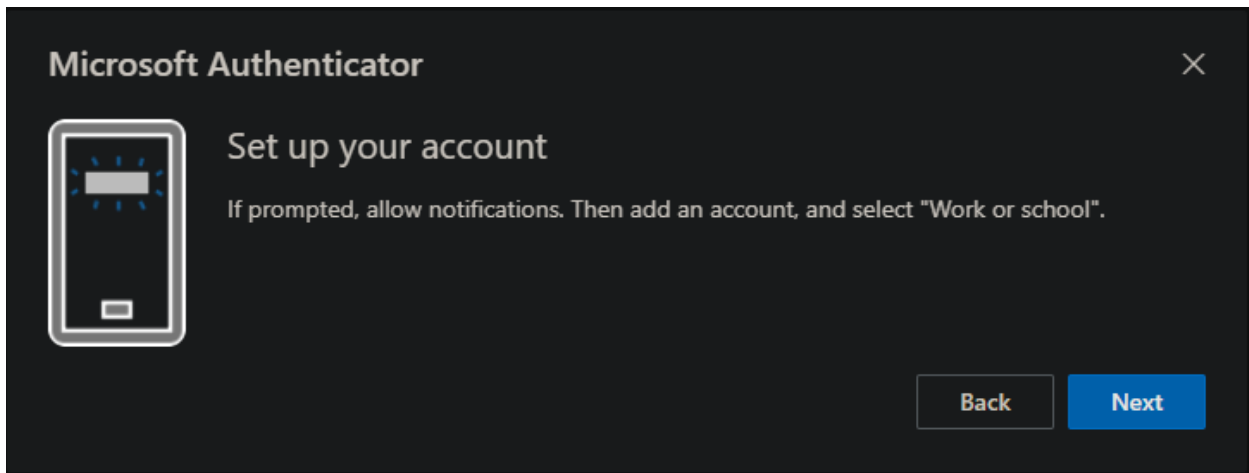
2. Select **Authenticator** and click on **Add**.
3. Download and install the Microsoft Authenticator app from your respective Android or Apple store.



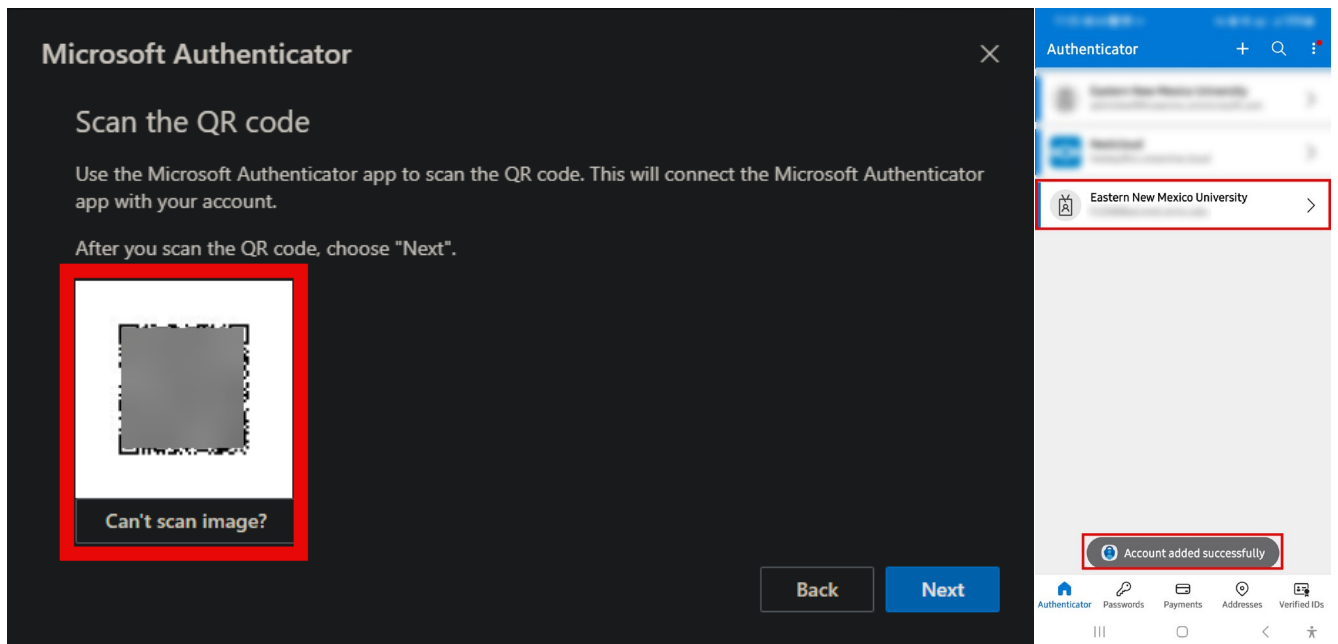
- Once the app is installed, open the app on your device. (Android shown)
- Click on the **+** to add your account.
- Select **Work or school account**.
- Select **Scan a QR code**.



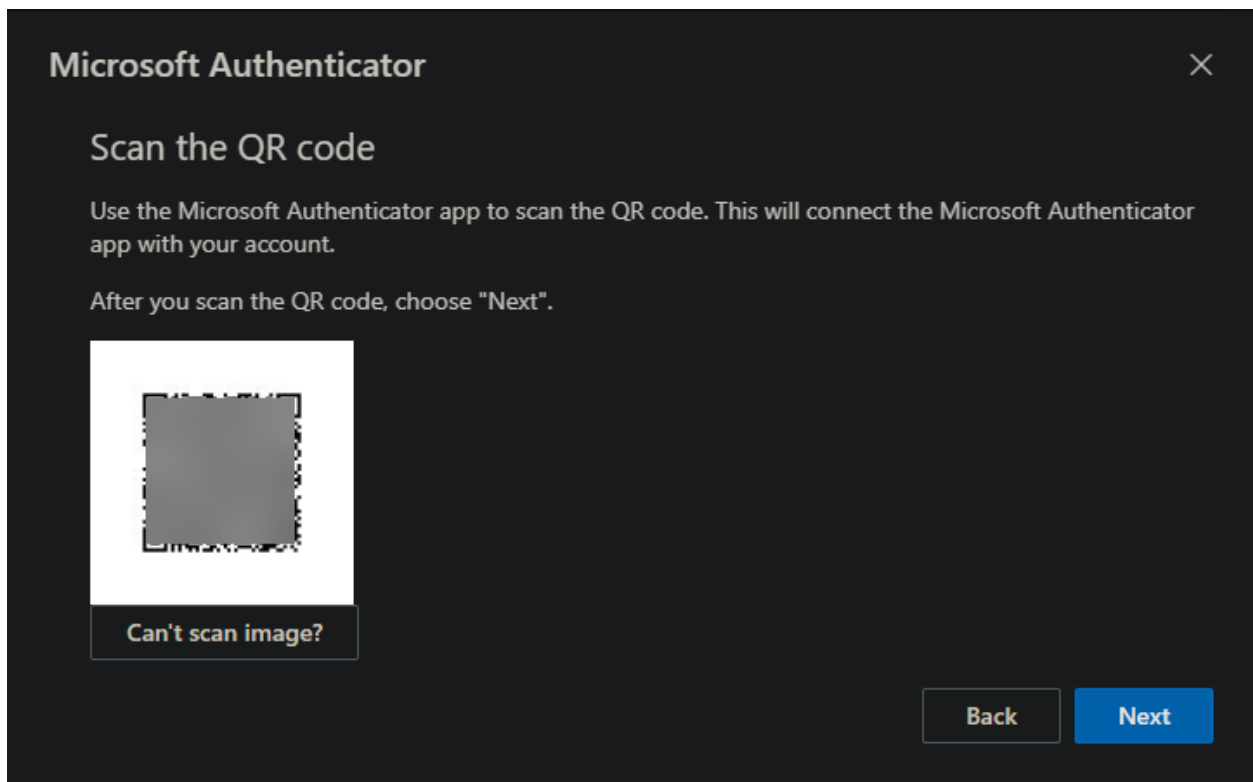
- Click **Next** on the screen.



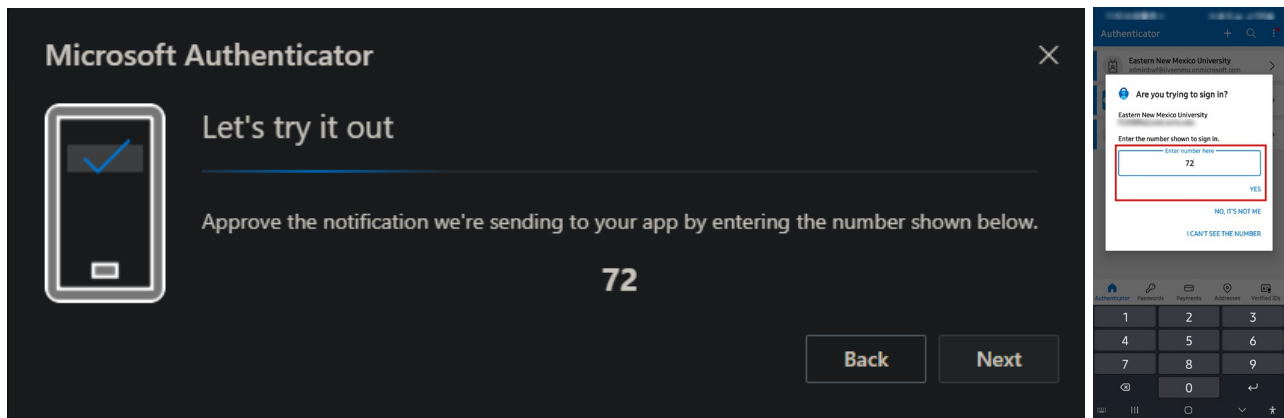
9. Scan the QR code that is displayed with the Microsoft Authenticator app.
10. Your ENMU account will be added to Microsoft Authenticator.



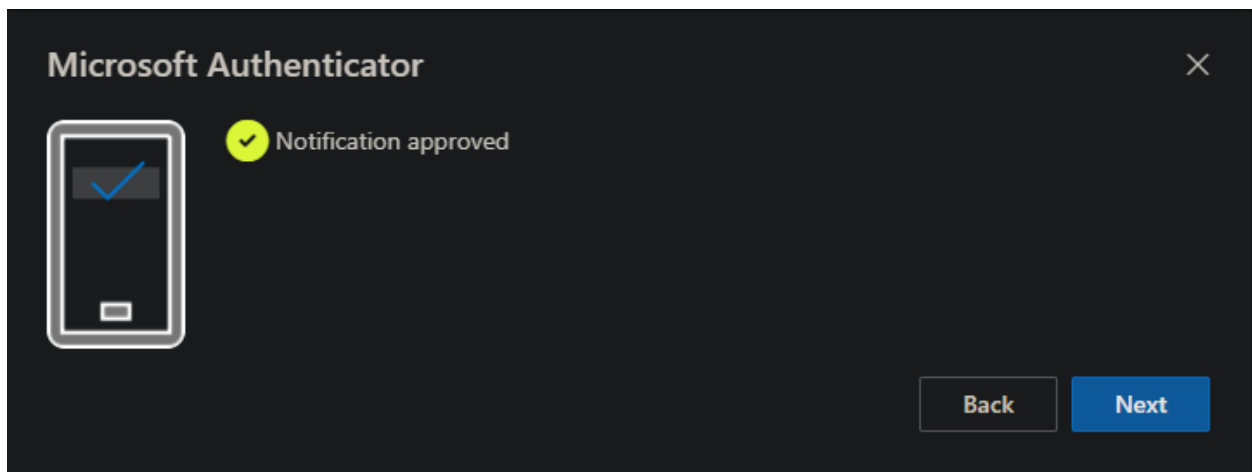
11. Click on **Next**.



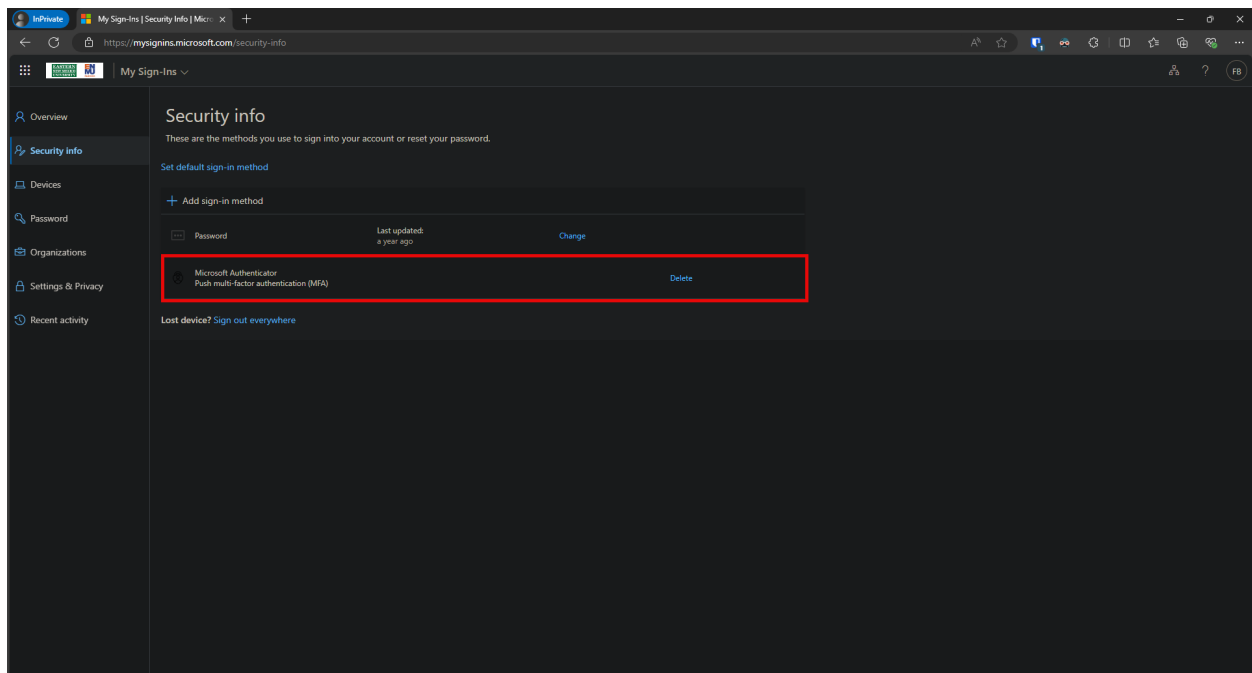
12. Enter the number shown on the screen into the Microsoft Authenticator app and tap on **Yes**.



13. Authentication test is successful. Click on **Next**.



14. Microsoft Authenticator will show up in your list of authentication methods.



15. You have now added the Microsoft Authenticator App to your ENMU account.
